The Expert Parent Programme (EPP)

The EPP is a Department of Health (DoH) funded programme developed in conjunction with the Council for Disabled Children. It is a parent carer empowerment programme that is designed to help families understand how to navigate the NHS system and to get the most out of their time with professionals to gain the best outcomes for their children.

Behaviours that Challenge Workshop
